

ENTREPRENEURSHIP

The Section of "ENTREPRENEURSHIP" of the Asociación Científica de Economía y Dirección de la Empresa (ACEDE) groups all University members shared interests in Business Creation and Entrepreneurship. Currently, the section is composed of more than one hundred members from all Spanish universities.

Among the objectives of the section are:

- Promote the exchange of experiences, knowledge and resources among its members to facilitate teaching duties, research and dissemination in the field of Entrepreneurship.
- Facilitate interaction with agents and institutions in other non-university areas so that a greater connection between research and teaching of Entrepreneurship with the needs of the business world and society in general demand we achieved.
- To promote critical analysis and collaboration among members to enhance academic and research activities that are developed from the universities to promote Entrepreneurship.

The first meeting of this working group took place on 28 May 1999 at the Universidad Autónoma de Barcelona and its official constitution as ACEDE's Section was agreed by the Board on December 17, 2001.

The main activities undertaken in the section are:

- Annual meeting inside the ACEDE Conference, with the participation of guests or speakers.
- Collaboration with the Association to award the prize to the best paper presenting to ACEDE Conference in this area.
- Celebration of an annual Section's Workshop with orientation towards teaching methods and research in Entrepreneurship.
- Editing a newsletter in the field of Entrepreneurship.
