Call for Editor-in-Chief and Associate Editors

BRQ - Business Research Quarterly is seeking candidates for Editor-in-Chief and Associate Editors for a term of four years.

BRQ is the official journal of ACEDE (Spanish Academy of Management). Born in 1998 as Cuadernos de Economía y Dirección de la Empresa (CEDE), the journal was indexed in the Social Science Citation Index in 2008, and it is published in English under the new title since 2014. BRQ is currently a Q3 in the fields of "Business" and "Management" of the Journal of Citation Reports, and a Q2 in "Business, Management and Accounting" within the Scimago Journal Rank.

Position descriptions

Editor-in-Chief

The primary responsibility of the Editor-in-Chief is to lead a group of Associate Editors whose mission is to enhance the journal's academic reputation. As the flagship of ACEDE's brand, this not only involves handling around 320 submissions per year, but also exploring new initiatives to spread and internationalize the journal's readership.

Candidates should possess the following qualifications:

- To be an ACEDE Member, at least since February 2017.
- Broad and outstanding academic expertise in business research with a strong track record of publications in management and/or economics journals.
- Commitment to and knowledge of ethics of research.
- Strong leadership qualities and ability to work effectively with other colleagues involved in the publication process, overseeing the editorial process and meeting deadlines.

Associate Editors

BRQ needs applicants with specific skills in at least one of the following areas: Finance, Corporate Governance, Strategy, Human Resource Management, Innovation Management, Entrepreneurship and Family Business. On the one hand, they will conduct peer review of manuscripts according to the Editorial Policy and, with the Editor-in-Chief and other Associate Editors, make autonomous publication decisions on assigned manuscripts. On the other hand, Associate Editors will suggest and participate in initiatives to increase the visibility of BRQ among current and potential readers.

Candidates should possess the following qualifications:

- A strong record of high-quality international publications.
- A wide scope of interests and skills to handle article submissions with very diverse problem statements and methodologies.
- A proved capacity to keep good records, maintain with authors and reviewers a constructive and respectful relation, and enforce the highest ethical standards.

Application process

Candidates may apply for one or for both types of positions. Send a short CV to brq@elsevier.com, and add a cover letter outlining the relevant experience, interest in the position and a description of your editorial vision for the journal. Please, write “Call for Editor-in-Chief and Associate Editors” in the email subject line.

The deadline for this specific call is February 28th 2018 (applications for Associate Editors, however, are welcome at any time).

A search committee, guaranteeing the anonymity of all candidatures, will review applications. This committee will provide a recommendation to ACEDE’s Board for consideration. An Extraordinary ACEDE Assembly, to be held in June 2018, will approve the final proposal.
